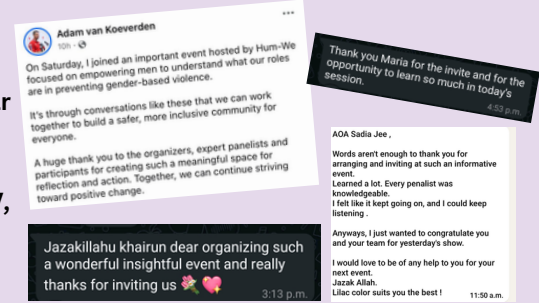


Hum Men Stand Together

Grant Acceptance

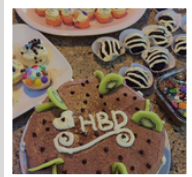

Workshops at Shelter



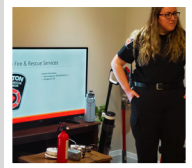
Self Care Workshop By: Zahra Syeda
